### **THE ORGANIZATION**

The Guthrie Theater engages exceptional theater artists in the exploration of both classic and contemporary plays connecting the community we serve to one another and to the world. ### **THE POSITION**

The Wig Assistant is responsible for assisting the Wig Master in building, dressing and maintaining wigs to help maintain the desired look of a production. Compensation for this union position is full time, non-exempt (hourly), with an hourly rate of \$24.31/hour.

### **Job Highlights**

- Build foundations for wigs and hairpieces.
- Builds wigs and hairpieces to create the desired look of a production.
- Ventilates hair.
- Cut and style finished wigs.
- Comb out wigs in the style determined by the designer or Wigmaster to maintain continuity of the look for the run of the production.
- Maintain style of wigs and hairpieces to ensure quality through the run of a production.
- Maintains wigs and hairpieces using thermal sets when necessary.
- Wash and wet set wigs as needed.
- Maintains actors hair to preserve the look of a production.
- Provide haircuts as needed.
- Teach actors how to apply product and maintain their look for the run of the production.
- Purchase hair care products such as shampoo, gel, and hairspray from beauty supply stores.
- Shop for supplies as determined by the Wigmaster in a timely manner.
- Other duties as needed or assigned.

### **Qualifications**

- One year of experience with wig construction and maintenance, or a combination of equivalent experience and training.

- Cosmetology license preferred but not required.
- Knowledge of hair and wig dressing.
- Knowledge of products used with hair and wigs.
- Ability to build wigs.
- Ability to move from project to project quickly and manage time efficiently.
- Knowledge of makeup and the application of makeup to assist actors during tech week.
- Ability to work effectively with a variety of personality types.
- Ability to foster positive working relationships.
- Strong commitment to diversity and inclusion.
- Experience, ability and commitment to working with diverse groups in terms of gender expression, race, sexual orientation, religion, ability, age, class and immigrant status.
